OUR SERVICES

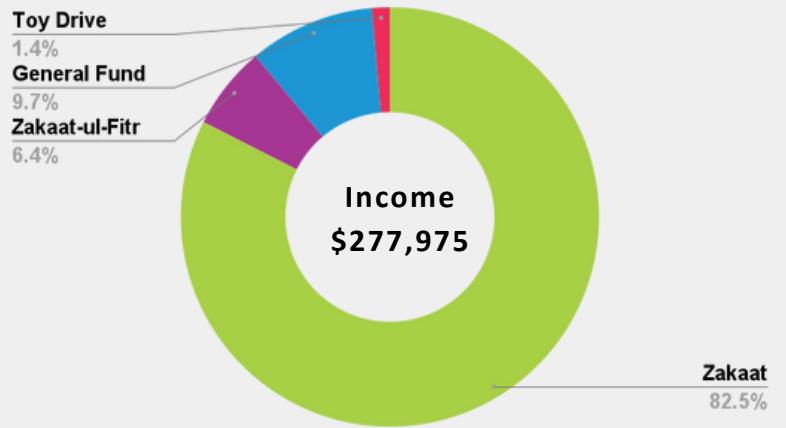
- Network with local Islamic Centers and masajids to manage Zakaat distribution, and address specific client situations. MCS coordinates donations of furniture, appliances, school supplies, and household items to local families in need.
- Provide urgent and short-term assistance to refugees, widows, single parents, and needy families in a way that emphasizes self-reliance.
- Guide clients to government assistance, job search agencies, counseling organizations, and mental health professionals to support individuals seeking it.
- Conduct financial review of clients' assets to ascertain if they are below Nisab, and certifies if each client is Zakaat eligible to determine the level of financial aid.

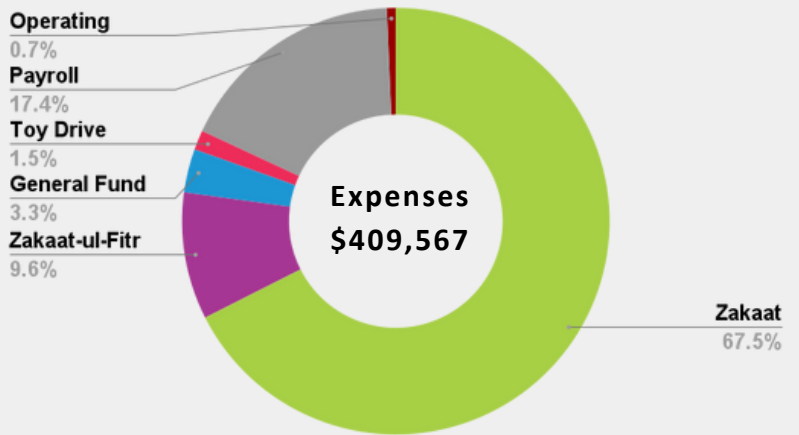

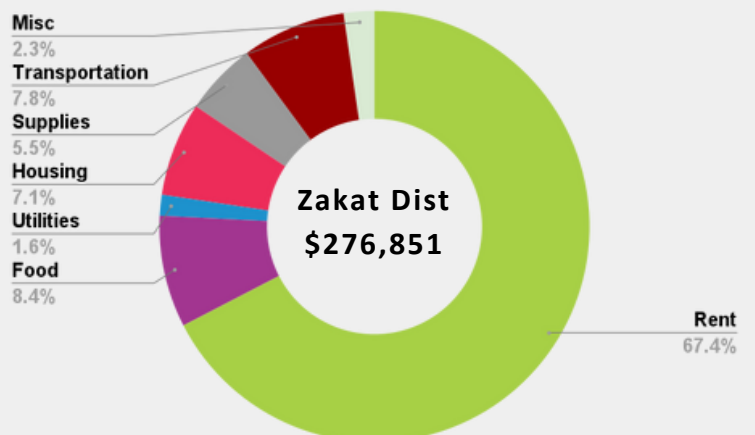
